

## Information Regarding Coronavirus (12.03.2020)

**Thank you for your interest in attending one of our medical education events. At this point in time, all of our events will be taking place as planned.**

In light of the COVID-19 outbreak, we are in a unique situation which is changing on a daily basis. We are fully aware of the increasing numbers of travel restrictions being placed on healthcare providers and hospitals and we are carefully monitoring updates and recommendations from, amongst others, The World Health Organisation (WHO).

Nobody can predict, with certainty, what the situation will be in June. The health, safety and well-being of all – faculty, staff, exhibitors, delegates - who participate in our annual Update is our highest priority.

**This event will be livestreamed** and therefore, if you are feeling uneasy in June about attending, we will offer to change your on-site ticket to a livestream ticket. You will still receive all of the content from the comfort of your own home or office, and will still be able to interact with the speakers through the live chat, and will still receive all the presentations to download after the event, including a selection of videos on-demand.

With this in mind, we confirm that this Update WILL CONTINUE as planned on the originally-scheduled dates. As of now, the congress will proceed in its usual format, unless the situation deteriorates. **In that case we will get in touch with all delegates immediately, and post an update here.**

We are working on taking the following measures to ensure the safety of our delegates on-site:

- 1) Placing disinfectant stations at every door in the congress location
- 2) Increasing the daily cleaning and disinfection cycle of the sanitary and toilette areas.

Please follow the known codes of conduct, in order to avoid the risk of infection from others, in the same way you would with other viral infections.
